



ASA PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

The following **advice for swimmers** is a condensed version of the ASA Policies on Photography. It is taken from the ASA Wavepower manual which covers best practice for the 'Safeguarding and Protection' of children within the sport of swimming. A copy of the manual is held with the Welfare Officer (Louise Chapman) and can be viewed on request or downloaded from the ASA website.



Unless fully clothed, all photos taken on the poolside should be above the waist.



If mobile phones are taken into the changing rooms, the facility to take photos must not be used.



Always remember that anything you say including photos, pictures and video clips posted on your site may be shared with other people for whom it was not intended.

Do not put pictures of other club members on the site unless you have the consent of both the swimmer and their parent.

No one should take a picture of you without your consent.
